## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE AMOUNT OF RECESS TIME REQUIRED FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS; TO AMEND THE AMOUNT OF INSTRUCTIONAL TIME REQUIRED FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS IN A SCHOOL DAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

> TO EXTEND THE AMOUNT OF RECESS TIME REQUIRED FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS; AND TO AMEND THE AMOUNT OF INSTRUCTIONAL TIME REQUIRED FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS IN A SCHOOL DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-102(a), concerning the definition of "school day", is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1) As used in this section, "school day" shall mean means a day in which classes are in session and students receive at least the following amount of instructional time each day:
(A) For students enrolled in kindergarten through grade four (K-4), at least five (5) hours and twenty (20) minutes;
(B) For students enrolled in grades five and six (5-6), at least five (5) hours and thirty-five (35) minutes; and
(C) For students enrolled in grades seven through twelve (7-12), at least six (6) hours of instructional time.
(2) Any day in which less than six (6) hours the amounts of instructional time under subdivision (a)(l) of this section are provided to
students shall be counted as one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of a school day if at least three (3) hours of instructional time are provided to students.
(3) Any day in which less than three (3) hours of instructional time are provided to students shall not be counted as any part of a school day.
(4) A school district may include as part of the school day the travel time between public schools or other educational programs of those students attending classes or programs authorized by law.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-16-102(c), concerning the average amounts of planned instructional time, is amended to read as follows:
(c) A school district is deemed to have fulfilled the requirements of subsection (a) of this section if the planned instructional time in each school day does not average averages not less than six (6) hours the amounts of instructional time under subdivision (a) (l) of this section each day of thirty (30) hours each week.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-16-132(b)(1), concerning physical activity requirements, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
(b)(l)(A) The physical education curriculum and physical activity requirements for every public school student who is able to participate are:
(i) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(l)(A)(ii) of this section, for students in kindergarten through grade six (K-6):
(a) At For students in kindergarten through grade six (K-6), at least forty (40) minutes, as determined by the superintendent of the school district, of physical education training and instruction each calendar week of the school year; and
(b) Ninety (90) minutes The following:
(1) For students in kindergarten through
grade four ( $\mathrm{K}-4$ ), three hundred forty (340) minutes of physical activity each calendar week of the school year, which may shall include without limitation daily recess, physical education training and instruction in addition to the requirement of under subdivision (b) (1) (A) (i) (a) of this section, or intramural sports and unstructured and undirected play under subdivision (b) (l) (B) of this section; and

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    (2) For students in grades five and six
    (5-6), two hundred sixty-five (265) minutes of physical activity each
    calendar week of the school year, which shall include without limitation
    physical education training and instruction under subdivision (b)(l)(A)(i)(a)
    of this section and unstructured and undirected play under subdivision
(b)(l)(B) of this section;
                            (ii) For students in grades five through eight (5-8)
who attend a public school organized to teach grades five through eight (5-
    8), or any combination thereof, at least forty (40) minutes, as determined by
    the superintendent of the school district, of physical education training and
    instruction each calendar week of the school year or an equivalent amount of
    time in each school year with no additional requirement for physical
    activity; and
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(iii) For students in grades nine through twelve (912), one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) unit of physical education as required for high school graduation with no additional requirement for physical activity.
(B) Students shall participate in unstructured and undirected play for the following amounts of time each day of the school year:
(i) For students in kindergarten through grade four (K-4), at least sixty (60) minutes; and
(ii) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(1)(A)(ii) of this section, for students in grades five and six (5-6), at least fortyfive (45) minutes.
(C) Nothing in subdivision (b)(1)(A) subdivisions (b)(l)(A) and (B) of this section prohibits:
(i) A public school student's elective enrollment or voluntary participation in physical activity or physical education as a part of public school curriculum or extra-curricular activities; or
(ii) A school district's decision to require physical education instruction or physical activity in excess of the amounts identified in subdivision (b)(l)(A) of this section.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-17-117(a)(2), concerning noninstructional duties, is amended to read as follows:
(2) Any teacher assigned more than sixty (60) one hundred forty






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[^0](140) minutes of noninstructional duties per week shall be contracted in accordance with § 6-17-807(g).

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
