1	(c) This section does not apply to a person who is validly exercising		
2	his or her rights as guaranteed by the United States Constitution or the		
3	Arkansas Constitution.		
4	(d) Unlawful mass picketing is a Class A misdemeanor.		
5	(e)(1) A person or entity who is harmed by unlawful mass picketing		
6	under this section may seek injunctive relief in the circuit court having		
7	jurisdiction to enjoin a person engaged in unlawful mass picketing from		
8	participating in unlawful mass picketing.		
9	(2) A court hearing a petition for injunctive relief under this		
10	subsection may award court costs and reasonable attorney's fees to a		
11	prevailing party as well as order a civil fine of up to one thousand dollars		
12	(\$1,000) per day for a person who violates an order enjoining him or her from		
13	engaging in unlawful mass picketing.
