Arkansas Code § 6-17-413(a)(3)(B) and (C), concerning 8 National Board for Professional Teaching Standards certification funding, is 9 amended to read as follows: 10 (B)(i) A teacher certified by the national board who moves 11 into the state on or before January 1, 2017 and is employed full time as a 12 classroom teacher, building-level principal, or building-level assistant 13 principal in an Arkansas public school district shall be eligible for the 14 yearly incentive bonus of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for every school 15 year the person is employed full time as a classroom teacher, building-level 16 principal, or building-level assistant principal in a local public school 17 district for the life of the certificate of the national board no more than 18 ten (10) school years. 19 (ii) A teacher who holds national board 20 certification on or after August 1, 2009, who moves into the state on or before January 1, 2017, shall be eligible for the yearly incentive bonus of 21 22 five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for every school year the teacher is employed 23 full time for the life of the certificate of the national board no more than 24 ten (10) school years if, after working for three (3) years with national 25 board certification as a classroom teacher, building-level principal, or 26 building-level assistant principal in a public school district in this state, 27 the teacher is employed as a teacher in an accredited teacher preparation 28 program at a state-supported institution of higher education if funds are 29 available after payments are made to those eligible under subdivisions 30 (a)(3)(A)(iv)(a) and (a)(3)(B)(i) of this section. 31 (C) The starting incentive bonus and the yearly incentive 32 set forth in subdivisions (a)(3)(A) and (B) of this section shall increase yearly as follows: 33 34 (i) The starting incentive bonus and the yearly 35 incentive for 2003 shall be three thousand dollars (\$3,000); 36 (ii) The starting incentive bonus and the yearly

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     speech-language pathologists, is amended to read as follows:
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           (d)(1) As used in this subsection, "speech-language pathologist" means
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     a speech-language pathologist who:
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                       (A) Has a master's degree, which includes medical-based
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     training;
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                       (B) Has completed a one-year clinical fellowship;
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                       (C) Has passed the specialty area of the National Teachers
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     Examination; and
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                       (D) Holds a Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-
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     Language Pathology from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association.
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                 (2) By December 1 of each year, the department shall pay a
     yearly incentive bonus of five thousand dollars ($5,000) to a speech-language
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     pathologist who:
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                       (A) Holds an Arkansas teaching license in speech-language
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     pathology;
                       (B) Is a full-time employee of an Arkansas education
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     service cooperative or public school district as a speech-language
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     pathologist at the time of receiving the bonus; and
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                       (C) Is not considered a purchased service contractor but
     may be employed under a teacher contract subject to renewal under § 6-17-
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     1506.
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                 (3)(A)(i) Bonuses paid to a certified speech-language
     pathologist under this subsection shall be paid from the funds appropriated
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     and available for bonuses to speech-language pathologists.
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                             (ii) If sufficient funds are not available to pay
     the full amount of the bonus to each certified speech-language pathologist as
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     provided under this section, the department may reduce the amount of the
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     bonus for each qualified recipient proportionately as necessary to provide a
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1	bonus to each qualified speech-language pathologist in an equal amount.
2	(B) The cost and expenses related to training for or
3	acquisition of the certificate shall not be funded through the program
4	created under this section and § 6-17-412 but shall be the responsibility of

7	a bonus under this subsection will hold a valid Arkansas teaching license in

11	(5)(A)(i) If a speech-language pathologist who receives a bonus
12	under this subsection leaves employment in the Arkansas public school system
13	before completing three (3) continuous school years of employment, the
14	speech-language pathologist shall repay the department a prorated portion of
15	the bonus received in the school year based on a daily rate for the remainder
16	of a school year in which the speech-language pathologist leaves employment.
17	(ii) The first year of the three (3) continuous
18	school years is the first year that the speech-language pathologist received
19	a bonus under this subsection (d).
20	(iii) The daily rate is calculated as the amount of
21	the annual bonus paid to the speech-language pathologist divided by the
22	number of days in the speech-language pathologist's contract.
23	(B) The State Board of Education may suspend the Arkansas
24	speech-language pathology license of any person who fails to repay the amount
25	of the bonus required to be repaid under this subdivision (d)(5).
26	(C) Repayment of all or a portion of a bonus under this
27	subdivision (d)(5) is not required if, due to the death or disability of the
28	speech-language pathologist or other extenuating circumstances as may be
29	recognized by the State Board of Education, the speech-language pathologist
30	does not remain employed in the Arkansas public school system for three (3)
31	continuous school years after first receiving the bonus under this
32	subsection. The department shall pay a yearly incentive bonus to a person
33	who:
34	(A) On or after January 1, 2018, began the certification
35	process and received national board certification; and
36	(B) At the time of receiving the bonus is employed full-

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1	time in a public school, including an open-enrollment public charter school,
2	<u>as a:</u>
3	(i) Classroom teacher;
4	(ii) Instructional facilitator; or
5	(iii) Instructional leader.
6	(2) A yearly incentive bonus under this subsection shall be:
7	(A) Two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for a
8	person who at the time of receiving the bonus is employed full-time in a
9	public school, including an open-enrollment public charter school, that is
10	not a high-poverty school or a high-poverty charter school;
11	(B) Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for a person who at the
12	time of receiving the bonus is employed full-time in a high-poverty school
13	that is not in a high-poverty district; or
14	(C) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for a person who at the
15	time of receiving the bonus is employed full-time in a:
16	(i) High-poverty school in a high-poverty district;
17	<u>or</u>
18	(ii) High-poverty charter school.
19	(3) A yearly incentive bonus under this subsection shall be
20	<u>limited as follows:</u>
21	(A) A person shall not receive a two thousand five hundred
22	<u>dollar (\$2,500) bonus under subdivision (d)(2)(A) of this section in more</u>
23	<u>than five (5) school years;</u>
24	(B) A person shall not receive a five thousand dollar
25	<u>(\$5,000) bonus under subdivision (d)(2)(B) of this section in more than five</u>
26	<u>(5) school years;</u>
27	(C) A person shall not receive a ten thousand dollar
28	<u>(\$10,000) bonus under subdivision (d)(2)(C) of this section in more than ten</u>
29	<u>(10) school years;</u>
30	(D) A person shall not receive any yearly incentive bonus
31	under this subsection in more than ten (10) school years;
32	(E) A person shall not receive in the same school year
33	more than one yearly incentive bonus under subdivision (d)(2) of this

7	(e) As used in this section:
8	(1) "High-poverty charter school" means an Arkansas open-
9	enrollment public charter school in which seventy percent (70%) or greater of
10	the previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch
11	students as defined in § 6-20-2303;
12	(2) "High-poverty district" means an Arkansas public school
13	district in which seventy percent (70%) or greater of the previous school
14	year's enrolled students are national school lunch students as defined in §
15	<u>6-20-2303;</u>
16	(3) "High-poverty school" means an Arkansas public school in
17	which seventy percent (70%) or greater of the previous school year's enrolled
18	students are national school lunch students as defined in § 6-20-2303; and
19	(4)(A) "Instructional leader" means a building-level
20	administrator who is responsible for evaluating teachers or instructional
21	<u>staff.</u>
22	(B) "Instructional leader" includes without limitation a
23	building-level administrator who is an evaluator as defined in § 6-17-2803.
