3	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue

6	(b) The Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training Fund		
7	shall consist of:		
8	(1) The fees collected by the Office of Motor Vehicle for noting		
9	a lien under § 27-14-602(b)(3) and distributed as required under § 27-14-

11	(2) Any other revenues authorized by law.		
12	(c) The Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training:

23	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Department of Arkansas
25	State Police Commission Health Plan is a recruiting tool that helps the
26	Department of Arkansas State Police recruit and maintain commissioned
27	officers: and the Department of Arkansas State Police Commission Health Plan
28	is in need of a dedicated revenue stream to sustain the health plan for
29	future years and generations of State Troopers. Therefore, an emergency is
30	declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
31	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on and after July 1,
32	<u>2017.</u>
