- (c) In the event that the department, acting pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Arkansas State Police Commission therefor, exercises the option to establish a self-insurance program, this program shall provide hospitalization and medical services coverage for uniformed eligible employees of the department and for the spouses and dependents of uniformed 7 personnel eligible employees of the department as authorized in this section and shall be operated in accordance with policies, rules, procedures, and benefits prescribed by the commission.
  - (d) Members of the department who retire and receive retirement benefits under the State Police Retirement System after July 1, 1985, shall be eligible to participate in the group health self-insurance program established by the commission for uniformed personnel eligible employees and for their spouses and dependents in the same manner and under the same conditions as provided in  $\S\S 21-5-410-21-5-412$ , which authorize retired state employees receiving retirement benefits under the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System to participate in the state employees' hospitalization and medical insurance program State and Public School Life and Health Insurance Program.
  - (e) As used in this section, "eligible employee" means an employee or individual who is a full-time employee of the department and is qualified to enroll in a health benefit plan offered by the department or the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance Program.
