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14	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-13-807 is amended to read as follows:		
15	20-13-807. Trauma Advisory Council.		
16	(a) There is established an advisory council, to be known as the		
17	"Trauma Advisory Council", for the purpose of making recommendations,		
18	advising, and providing assistance to the Department of Health concerning the		
19	development and operation of a statewide trauma system.		
20	(b) The council shall consist of $\frac{1}{1}$ ten (10) voting members		
21	who have a demonstrated interest in trauma systems to be appointed by the		
22	Governor subject to confirmation by the Senate as follows:		
23	(1) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting		
24	the Arkansas Chapter of the American College of Emergency Physicians;		
25	(2) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting		
26	the Arkansas Academy of Family Physicians;		
27	$\frac{(3)}{(2)}$ One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting		
28	the Arkansas Chapter of the American College of Surgeons;		
29	$\frac{(4)}{(3)}$ One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting		
30	the Arkansas Medical Society;		
31	$\frac{(5)(4)}{(5)}$ Four $\frac{(4)}{(5)}$ Three $\frac{(3)}{(5)}$ members appointed by the Governor		
32	after consulting the Arkansas Hospital Association;

21	(c) The council shall also include four (4) voting members who have a
22	demonstrated interest in trauma systems to be appointed as follows:
23	(1) Two (2) members to be appointed by and to serve at the
24	pleasure of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and
25	(2) Two (2) members to be appointed by and to serve at the
26	pleasure of the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
27	(d) The following Director of the Department of Health or his or her
28	$\underline{\text{designee}}$ shall serve as $\underline{a}$ nonvoting ex officio $\underline{\text{members}}$ $\underline{\text{member}}$ of the council:
29	(1) The Director of the Department of Health or the director's
30	designee; and
31	(2) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police or
32	the director's designee.
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34	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-13-808(e)(1), concerning a quorum of the
35	Trauma Advisory Council, is amended to read as follows:
36	(a)(1) Thirteen (13) Fight (8) of the voting members of the council

T	shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of transacting pusiness.
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3	SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. Education requirements
4	within the rules of the Department of Health regarding trauma systems.
5	Until March 1, 2019, the Department of Health may either waive or
6	substitute educational requirements within the rules regarding trauma systems
7	to ensure that hospitals retain their trauma level designation.
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
