6	employees of the department and for the spouses and dependents of uniformed		
7	personnel eligible employees of the department as authorized in this section		
8	and shall be operated in accordance with policies, rules, procedures, and		
9	benefits prescribed by the commission.		
10	(d) Members of the department who retire and receive retirement		
11	benefits under the State Police Retirement System after July 1, 1985, shall		
12	be eligible to participate in the group health self-insurance program		
13	established by the commission for uniformed personnel <u>eligible retirees</u> and		
14	for their spouses and dependents in the same manner and under the same		
15	conditions as provided in §§ $21-5-410-\frac{21-5-412}{21-5-411}$, which authorize		
16	retired state employees receiving retirement benefits under the Arkansas		
17	Public Employees' Retirement System to participate in the state employees'		
18	hospitalization and medical insurance program State and Public School Life		
19	and Health Insurance Program.		
20	(e) As used in this section:		
21	(1) "Eligible employee" means an individual who is:		
22	(A) A full-time employee of the department as defined in		
23	the Plan Document for the Arkansas State Police Health Benefit Plan; and		
24	(B) Qualified to enroll in the health benefit plan offered		
25	by the department; and		
26	(2) "Eligible retiree" means an employee who:		
27	(A) Retires under the department's formal retirement plan;		
28	(B) Is eligible to continue to participate in the		
29	retirement plan upon retirement as defined in the Plan Document for the		
30	Arkansas State Police Health Benefit Plan; and		
31	(C) Is qualified to enroll in the health benefit plan		
32	offered by the department.
