2	15-57-204. Quartz crystal mined on private property		
3	(a) A private property owner that mines quartz crystal on the private		
4	property shall remove topsoil and spoil and store it on the mining site		
5	separately for future reclamation needs.		
6	(b) Upon completion of mining on private property, the private		
7	property owner shall:		
8	(1) Leave the mining site in a condition that safeguards the		
9	mining site from trespass if any highwalls are left on the mining site; and		
10	(2)(A) Whenever possible:		
11	(i) Backfill spoil into the pits;		
12	(ii) Cover the mining site with topsoil; and		
13	(iii) Revegetate the mining site to prevent		
14	pollution of the waters of Arkansas.		
15	(B) If the owner does not place spoil back into the final		
16	cut, the owner shall:		
17	(i) Grade the spoil so that no slope is steeper than		
18	one foot (1') vertical to three feet (3') horizontal; and		
19	(ii) Respread and revegetate the topsoil to prevent		
20	pollution of the waters of Arkansas.		
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
