30	(a) The General Assembly finds that:		
31	(1) Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 13, provides that the		
32	sessions of each house of the General Assembly and of committees of the whole		
33	shall be open, unless when the business is such as ought to be kept secret;		
34	<u>(2) Desp</u>	ite the authority granted by Ark	kansas Constitution,
35	Article 5, § 13, the	General Assembly as a whole and	committees of the
36	General Assembly stri	ve to conduct their business in	an open and transparent

2	(3) Certain subject matter, information, and deliberations		
3	pertaining to appeals of decisions of the Arkansas State Claims Commission		
4	may involve information confidential under Arkansas law or otherwise		
5	sensitive to public disclosure;		
6	(4) When serving in a quasi-judicial role while hearing appeals		
7	of decisions of the commission, the committees and subcommittees of the		
8	General Assembly require the discretion to conduct their examinations and		
9	deliberations pertaining to certain appeals in a private and confidential		
10	manner similar to other appellate entities; and		
11	(5) To avoid confusion, certain committees and subcommittees of		
12	the General Assembly should be given specific authority to hold closed		
13	meetings when necessary to conduct their business when hearing an appeal of a		
14	decision of the commission.		
15	(b) When meeting to consider the appeal of a decision of the		
16	commission, the following committees or subcommittees of the General Assembly		
17	may conduct all or part of the meeting as a closed meeting as deemed		
18	necessary by the chairs of the committees or subcommittees:		
19	(1) The Claims Review Subcommittee of the Legislative Council;		
20	(2) The Claims Subcommittee of the Joint Budget Committee;		
21	(3) The Legislative Council; and		
22	(4) The Joint Budget Committee.		
23	(c) A committee or subcommittee meeting to consider the appeal of a		
24	decision of the commission shall not make a motion or vote upon a motion		
25	during a portion of a meeting conducted as a closed meeting.		
26	(d) This section does not limit the power of the General Assembly and		
27	the committees and subcommittees of the General Assembly regarding their		
28	meetings, including without limitation powers granted under:		
29	(1) Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 13; and		
30	(2) Other relevant provisions of the Arkansas Constitution.
