1 (B) (i) A written An online or written examination that 2 shows the applicant's ability to have common knowledge to exercise ordinary 3 and reasonable control in the operation of a motorboat and a personal 4 watercraft. 5 The course of instruction may be offered in cooperation with (3) 6 schools, private clubs, and organizations and may be offered by the 7 commission in areas where requested and where other sponsorship is 8 unavailable. 9 (4) The commission shall also prepare and disseminate 10 information on water safety to the public, including informational pamphlets, 11 which shall be made available at popular tourist locations. 12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-101-501(d), concerning the boater 13 14 training and boater safety program, is amended to read as follows: 15 (d)(1) In order to operate a motorboat or a personal watercraft in 16 Arkansas, all Arkansas residents a person born on or after January 1, 1986, 17 and of legal age to operate a motorboat or personal watercraft must shall 18 have successfully completed: 19 (A) A <u>a</u> commission-approved safe boating course and 20 examination under subdivision (b)(2) of this section to obtain a permanent 21 boater education certificate; or 22 (B) A questionnaire to obtain a temporary boater education 23 certificate under subsection (d)(4) of this section. 24 (2) The commission shall issue boating education certificates 25 and furnish a copy of the state laws pertaining to the operation of a motorboat or personal watercraft or informational material based on these 26 27 laws to persons successfully completing an approved safe boating course and 28 examination. 29 (3) Valid boating education certificates issued by other states 30 to nonresidents shall be honored by this state if the boating education 31 course is approved by the National Association of State Boating Law 32 Administrators. 33 (4) Prior to operating a motorboat or a personal watercraft on the waters of this state, a nonresident or resident born on or after January 34 1, 1986, and of legal age to operate a motorboat or a personal watercraft may 35 36 obtain a temporary boater education certificate, which shall be valid for

1	thirty (30) days, by completing a questionnaire developed by the commission.	
2	(5)(A) The application of any person under eighteen (18) years	
3	of age for a permanent or temporary boater education certificate shall be	
4	signed and verified before a person authorized to administer oaths by either	
5	the custodial parent or guardian of the applicant.	
6	(B) For purposes of this section, duly authorized agents	
7	of the commission shall be authorized to administer oaths without charge.
