19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:		
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas	s Code § 17-95-412(b), as am	ended by Act 147 of 2017
22	and concerning the requirements for an educational license for a physician,		
23	is amended to read as follows:

9	Coordinating Board to seek accreditation by an accrediting agency recognized		
10	by the United States Department of Education a medical school accredited by		
11	an accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education		
12	or approved by the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board to seek		
13	accreditation by an accrediting agency recognized by the United States

16	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
17	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act amends a portion of		
18	law previously amended by Act 147 of 2017; that Act 147 contained an		
19	emergency clause and is already in effect; and that this act should become		
20	effective at the earliest opportunity to avoid confusion and conflict in the		
21	effective date of the two (2) acts. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
22	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the		
23	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
24	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
25	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
26	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
27	bill; or		
28	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
29	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
