19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-95-412(b), as amended by Act 147 of 2	017
22	and concerning the requirements for an educational license for a physician	,
23	is amended to read as follows:	
24	(b)(1) The physician shall:	
25	(A) Submit an application to the board;	
26	(B) Provide information as the board may by rule require	e;
27	(C) Pay a licensure fee that the board may set by rule	to
28	cover the costs of administering the program; and

5	(2) The educational license to practice medicine in the State of
6	Arkansas shall authorize the practice of medicine only within the clinical
7	and educational programs <u>in the State of Arkansas that are</u> established and
8	administered by a medical school in this state accredited by an accrediting
9	agency recognized by the United States Department of Education or approved by
10	the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board to seek accreditation by an
11	accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education a
12	medical school accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the United
13	States Department of Education or approved by the Arkansas Higher Education
14	Coordinating Board to seek accreditation by an accrediting agency recognized
15	by the United States Department of Education.
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17	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
18	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act amends a portion of
19	law previously amended by Act 147 of 2017; that Act 147 contained an
20	emergency clause and is already in effect; and that this act should become
21	effective at the earliest opportunity to avoid confusion and conflict in the
22	effective date of the two (2) acts. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
23	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
24	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
28	bill; or
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
