           SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

     CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

     LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly, in the
22
     transition to a state-funded deputy prosecuting attorney system, to provide
23
     an appropriate and adequate level of legal representation through deputy
24
     prosecuting attorneys in all areas of the state. It is recognized by the

     General Assembly that in many areas of the state, resources have not been
26
     available to support deputy prosecuting attorney salaries at the necessary
27
     level. With the transition of local funding of deputy prosecuting attorney

     salaries to state funding, it is not the intent of the General Assembly to

     adversely affect those districts whose system has been working well or to

     implement a system which is too inflexible to respond to the needs of each

     judicial district. Therefore, the Prosecution Coordination Commission is

     charged with the responsibility of assisting in the maintenance of a system

     which equitably serves all areas of the state by providing quality deputy

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
