17	WHEREAS, more than one-third $(1/3)$ of children, adolescents, and adults		
18	are overweight or obese in the United States according to the 2016		
19	"Assessment of Childhood and Adolescent Obesity in Arkansas: Year 13" and the		
20	Trust for America's Health reports; and		
21			
22	WHEREAS, overweight and obese individuals are more likely to be at risk		
23	for cardiovascular disease, high blood pressure, type 2 diabetes, and joint		
24	problems; and		
25			
26	WHEREAS, Arkansas improved its ranking for obesity from first in 2015		
27	to sixth in 2016 among all the states, with the Arkansas obesity rate		
28	dropping from thirty-five and nine-tenths percent (35.9%) to thirty-four and		
29	five-tenths percent (34.5%) as reported by the Trust for America's Health;

32	WHEREAS, reversing the epidemic of obesity will require investing in		
33	prevention, making healthy choices an easier part of people's daily lives,		
34	and targeting efforts in areas in which there are the greatest challenges;

1	WHEREAS, according to the 2015 Healthy Active Arkansas Report, reducing			
2	the average body mass index of Arkansans by five percent (5%) could lead to			
3	health care savings of more than two billion dollars (\$2,000,000,000) in ten			
4	(10) years and six billion dollars ($$6,000,000,000$) in twenty (20) years,			
5	while also preventing thousands of cases of stroke, coronary heart disease,			
6	type 2 diabetes, hypertension, and cancer; and

8	WHEREAS, Healthy Active Arkansas is a comprehensive plan to address			
9	these areas in a systematic manner that was initiated by leaders in the			
10	public and private sector and was officially endorsed and launched in 2015 by			
11	Governor Asa Hutchinson; and			
12				
13	WHEREAS, Healthy Active Arkansas offers a framework for encouraging and			
14	enabling healthier lifestyles in Arkansas with a "health in all policies"			
15	approach that encompasses eight (8) priority areas: physical and built			
16	environment; nutritional standards in government, institutions, and the			
17	private sector; nutritional standards in schools, from early child care			
18	through college; healthy worksites; access to healthy foods; sugar-sweetened			
19	beverage reduction; breastfeeding; and a marketing program,

21	NOW THEREFORE,			
22	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE			
23	STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:			
24				
25	THAT the General Assembly recognizes the importance of preventing			
26	childhood and adulthood obesity and supports Healthy Active Arkansas and the			
27	eight (8) priority areas to address the obesity epidemic.			
28				
29	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the General Assembly encourages a "health			
30	in all policies" approach with specific goals and activities aimed at			
31	promoting healthy eating and physical activity and increasing awareness of			
32	Arkansas obesity rates among all ages and walks of life.			
33				
34	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, the			
35	Secretary of the Senate shall mail a copy of this resolution to the Governor,			
36	the Director of the Department of Health, and each member of the Arkansas
