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1 WHEREAS, it was not until the 1950s that he changed his name to Jimmy 2 Driftwood and began pursuing a musical career; and recorded his first album, "Newly Discovered Early American Folk Songs" in 1957, an album that was 3 4 highly praised by critics; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Jimmy Driftwood moved to Nashville, Tennessee, and became 7 popular through his appearances on the Grand Ole Opry; and his musical career 8 reached its height in 1959, when he had 6 songs on popular and country music 9 charts, including a recording of "The Battle of New Orleans" by singer Johnny Horton that won the 1960 Grammy Award for Song of the Year; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, during his recording career, Jimmy Driftwood also won Grammy Awards for "Wilderness Road", "Songs of Billy Yank and Johnny Reb", and 13 14 "Tennessee Stud"; and he had songs recorded by Eddy Arnold, Johnny Cash, 15 Hawkshaw Hawkins, Homer and Jethro, Odetta, Doc Watson, and many others; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Jimmy Driftwood returned to Arkansas around 1963, where he 18 became a folklorist, establishing the Rackensack Folklore Society and 19 promoting local folk singers and musicians by creating the Arkansas Folk 20 Festival; helped establish the Ozark Folk Center to preserve Ozark Mountain 21 culture; worked to defeat the United States Army Corps of Engineers' plan to 22 dam the Buffalo River, which resulted in the establishment of the Buffalo 23 National River; had a major role in preserving Blanchard Springs Caverns; was 24 appointed to direct the Arkansas Parks and Tourism Commission for his 25 efforts; was named to the Advisory Committee of the John F. Kennedy Center 26 for the Performing Arts; and served as a musicologist for the National 27 Geographic Society, 28 29 NOW THEREFORE, 30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE 31 STATE OF ARKANSAS: 32 33 THAT the Senate recognizes and honors the rich legacy of Jimmy 34 Driftwood and his contributions to Arkansas and to American folk culture. 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, an appropriate
