16	SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

18	CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION - UTILITIES DIVISION. In the event of unforeseen
19	conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not
20	authorized or contemplated in the Utilities Division appropriation of this
21	Act and such events make it necessary that the Public Service Commission -
22	Utilities Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the
23	objectives of the agency, the Director of the Public Service Commission is

1 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION - TAX DIVISION. In the event additional 4 appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in 5 the Tax Division appropriation of this Act and specific cases, situations, 6 and/or programs make it necessary that the Arkansas Public Service Commission 7 - Tax Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the objectives 8 of the Division, the Chairman of the Arkansas Public Service Commission is 9 hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief 10 Fiscal Officer of the State for transfers of the appropriations provided in 11 the Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act to 12 other line items within the Tax Division appropriation. In no event shall 13 the transfers in any fiscal year exceed the appropriations provided in the 14 Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act. 15 Governor may approve or modify such request for transfer of appropriations as 16 in his or her judgment he or she deems necessary, and shall seek prior review 17 and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council and inform the Chief Fiscal 18 Officer of the State. Further, the General Assembly 27 has determined that the Public Service Commission - Tax Division may operate 28 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Public Service 29 Commission - Tax Division authorizing broad powers under this Section. 30 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 31 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 32 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of 33 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 34 severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the 35 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a 36 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

4	SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

8	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
13	
14	SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23	SECTION 15. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
