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SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION - UTILITIES DIVISION. In the event of unforeseen conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in the Utilities Division appropriation of this Act and such events make it necessary that the Public Service Commission -Utilities Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the objectives of the agency, the Director of the Public Service Commission is hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as hereinafter provided, for transfer of the additional appropriations provided in the Contingency appropriation to the appropriations provided by the Utilities Division appropriation, but in no event shall the transfers exceed the appropriations provided in the Contingency appropriation of this Act. Whenever the Director of the Public Service Commission deems it necessary to establish additional appropriations as authorized herein, he or she shall file with the Governor a written report accompanied by necessary supporting documents setting forth the facts, justifications, and circumstances that necessitate such appropriation. Upon receipt of such reports and supporting documents, the Governor, or his or her designee, shall study the same, and if he or she shall determine that such

additional appropriations are being sought in strict compliance with this

- 1 Act, the Governor, after seeking prior review and prior approval by the
- 2 Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee, may approve or
