26	COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. Section 101(a)(7) of the
27	Rehabilitation Act Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to	as the
28	Comprehensive System of Personnel Development (CSPD), requir	es State
29	Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies to establish qualifi	ed personnel
30	standards for rehabilitation personnel, including VR counsel	ors, that are

- 13 FORGIVENESS OF STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM. The Forgiveness of Student Loan Program
