19	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS				
20	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER				
21	BY WARRANT. If, during the $\frac{2017-2018}{2018-2019}$ fiscal year, the need arises				
22	for additional funding for student loans and additional funds become				
23	available, the Director of the State Board of Pharmacy may request the Chief				
24	Fiscal Officer of the State to cause a transfer by warrant up to fifty

14	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
