22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
25 for the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional
26 Surveyors for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following maximum number of
27 regular employees.

 4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Board
 5 of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors for the
 6 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 7 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 8 herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when
 9 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 10 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 11 appropriate classification.

 13 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 14 to the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional
 15 Surveyors, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury
 16 as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services
 17 and operating expenses of the State Board of Licensure for Professional
 18 Engineers and Professional Surveyors for the fiscal year ending June 30,
 19 2019, the following:

 34 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7
 8 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

 17 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
 18 2018.
