- 18 methodology recommended by the Chief Information Officer and the CIO Council,
- 19 including an analysis of the return on investment and linkage to the
- 20 Department's business objectives. Any approved projects and expenditures for
- 21 information technology from the Environmental Settlement Trust Fund shall be
- 22 reported annually to the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and
- 23 Information Technology.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2017}{1}$
- 25 <u>2018</u> through June 30, <del>2018</del> <u>2019</u>.

- 27 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
- 29 TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
- 30 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may transfer from various
- 31 department funds to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fund
- 32 Account the sum of \$1,500,000 in fiscal year <del>2017-2018</del> 2018-2019 for the
- 33 exclusive purpose of supplementing funding for the appropriation provided in
- 34 the State Operations appropriation section. The funds shall be used for
- 35 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Department of
- 36 Environmental Quality State Operations. Funds which remain in the Arkansas

- 10 REQUIREMENTS. For the purposes of the fund transfers provided for in the

- 13 the use of funds for administration of programs of the Department.
- 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017

- 19 POST-CLOSURE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Any expenditures in excess of \$50,000

- 22 appropriation section, for corrective action to remedy environmental impacts
- 23 of closed disposal sites previously operated as a landfill pursuant to state

- landfills closed properly. Expenditures exceeding \$2,000,000 per fiscal year

- 31 SECTION 46. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NON
- 33 HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas
- 34 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the cleanup of non
- 35 hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in
- 36 the Non Hazardous Site Cleanup appropriation section, shall be funded only

- 1 through interest earnings from the Arkansas Department of Environmental
- 2 Quality Fee Trust Fund. The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality
- 3 shall seek cost recovery from parties responsible for damages to the
- 4 environment that dictate the use of appropriation authorized in the Non

- 13 POST-CLOSURE TRUST FUND.
- 14 (a) The General Assembly finds that:
- 15 (1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts
- 16 within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of
- 17 closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and
- 18 (2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills,
- 19 irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.
- 20 (b) Notwithstanding Arkansas Code § 8-6-1001 et seq. and any Landfill
- 21 Post-Closure Trust Fund cleanup restrictions enumerated in this Act, the
- 22 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may:
- 23 (1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a
- 24 state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to
- 25 complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure

- 7 SUSPENSION OF LANDFILL DISPOSAL FEES TO SUPPORT A COMPUTER AND ELECTRONIC
- 8 EQUIPMENT RECYCLING PROGRAM.
- 9 (a) The landfill disposal fee to support a computer and electronic 10 equipment recycling program levied under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(a) shall not 11 be levied from the effective date of this act through June 30, 2018 2019.
- 12 (b) Any landfill disposal fees collected under Arkansas Code § 8-6-13 612(a) before the effective date of this act shall be:
  - (1) Collected as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(c); and
- 15 (2) Distributed as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-616 and
- 16 this Act.
- The provision of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, <del>2017</del> 2018 through June 30, <del>2018</del> 2019.

- 20 SECTION 49. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 22 INVESTMENTS. All funds that are held at any time in the Landfill Post-
- 23 Closure Trust Fund, Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund, and
- 24 Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund may be invested and reinvested, subject to
- 25 the written approval of the Officer of the Treasurer, to the extent feasible,
- 26 and all investments as authorized for use by the Office of the Treasurer may
- 27 be available to the listed funds. The movement of these funds into and out
- 28 of investments shall be by fund transfers as directed by the Director of the
- 29 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality.

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SECTION 50. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
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7	SECTION 51. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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16	SECTION 52. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
