20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Arkansas State University - Mid-South for the 2018-2019 fiscal year,

17 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 18 the Arkansas State University - Mid-South for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the
 19 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 20 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two
 21 hundred (200) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay
 22 not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation
 23 Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 26 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Mid-South, to be payable
 27 from the Arkansas State University Mid-South Fund, for personal services and
 28 operating expenses of the Arkansas State University - Mid-South for the
 29 fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the following:

9 SECTION 6. ALLOCATIONS - ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS. There is
 10 hereby allocated to the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium

 13 this Act, there to be used as provided by in this Act, for the period ending

28 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

30 ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS - TRAINING CONSORTIUM ADVICE. The Arkansas
 31 State University Mid-South upon counsel with and advice from the Arkansas
 32 Delta Training and Education Consortium (ADTEC) shall disburse funds from the
 33 ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS appropriation authorized in this Act to
 34 selected University Center Partners and also the participating ADTEC
 35 Partners.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~

1 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

3 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
9 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
10 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
11 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
12 with in disbursement of said funds.
13

14 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
