8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 ARKANSAS STATE POLICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
15 STATE POLICE REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be
22 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
23 accounts, for the Department of Arkansas State Police the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 407 of 2017, for maintenance, renovation,
26 construction, equipping, improvement, upgrade, land acquisition and repairs,
27 in a sum not to exceed\$160,500.

28 (B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 407 of 2017, for radio repeater
30 infrastructure replacement on the Arkansas Wireless Information Network, in a
31 sum not to exceed\$1,370,943.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for fleet vehicle purchase,
34 equipping and sales tax, in a sum not to exceed\$9,200,000.

35 (D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for Bell Helicopter maintenance,



1 in a sum not to exceed\$250,000.

2 (E) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for software and hardware to
4 implement an online reporting system for Crimes Against Children Division
5 mandated reporters, in a sum not to exceed\$750,000.

6 (F) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for the replacement of microwave
8 radio equipment installed on the Arkansas Wireless Information Network
9 (AWIN), in a sum not to exceed\$12,900,000.

10 (G) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for Lonoke County Tower
12 replacement and relocation, in a sum not to exceed\$850,000.

13 (H) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for building and tower
15 remediation of the Arkansas Wireless Information System, in a sum not to
16 exceed\$1,500,000.

17 (I) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for hardware and software to
19 track radio system traffic of the AWIN User Management System, in a sum not
20 to exceed\$100,000.

21 (J) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 226 of 2017, for various maintenance,
23 operations, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
24 repair of the Arkansas Wireless Information Network system, in a sum not to
25 exceed\$10,000,000.

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27 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - STATE POLICE - TROOP L HEADQUARTERS.

28 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to
29 be payable from the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund, for the
30 Department of Arkansas State Police the following:

31 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 407 of 2017, for construction of a new ASP
33 Troop L Headquarters in Lowell, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed ..\$875,000.
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35 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
36 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects

1 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
2 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
3 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
4 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
5 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
6 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
7 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
8 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
9 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
10 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

11 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
12 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
13 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
14 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
15 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
16 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
17 otherwise by law.

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19 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
29 2018.
