REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS. 5 There is 6 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Correction, to be payable from the 7 Department of Correction Prison Industry Fund, for the Department of 8 Correction the following: 9 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 10 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 484 of 2017, for maintenance, replacement, 11 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement 12 and upgrade of the Department of Correction - Various Industry Projects, in a 13 sum not to exceed\$108,950. 14 15 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS FARM PROJECTS. There is hereby 16 appropriated, to the Department of Correction, to be payable from the 17 Department of Correction Farm Fund, for the Department of Correction the 18 following: 19 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 484 of 2017, for maintenance, replacement, 20 21 repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, 22 improvement, and upgrade of the Department of Correction - Various Farm 23 Projects, in a sum not to exceed\$140,534. Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 24 (B) 25 in Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 484 of 2017, for construction of grain 26 storage bins at the East Arkansas Unit, in a sum not to exceed\$200,000. 27 (C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 3 of Act 484 of 2017, for construction of grain 28 29 storage bins at the Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed\$200,000. 30 (D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 31 in Item (D) of Section 3 of Act 484 of 2017, for renovation of the current 32 Dairy facility and replacement of equipment, in a sum not to exceed 33\$2,799,800. 34 (E) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 35 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 224 of 2017, for construction of grain 36 storage bins at Cummins, Tucker and East Arkansas Units, in a sum not to

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1 exceed\$2,430,250. 2 (F) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 3 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 224 of 2017, for maintenance and repair to 4 upgrade the existing feed mill at the Cummins Unit, in a sum not to exceed 5\$889,750.

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7 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 8 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 9 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 10 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 11 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 12 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 13 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 14 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 15 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 16 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 17 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 18 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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27 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 35

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SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
