## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE RIVERSIDE  
VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE RIVERSIDE VOCATIONAL  
TECHNICAL SCHOOL REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
Riverside Vocational Technical School, to be payable from the General  
Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Riverside  
Vocational Technical School the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 415 of 2017, for transfers of or refund to  
expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major  
maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or  
facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed .....\$39,743.

(B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 231 of 2017, for transfers of or refund to  
expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major  
maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or  
facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,000,000.

SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects



1 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
2 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
3 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
4 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
5 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
6 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
7 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
8 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
9 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
10 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

11 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
12 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
13 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
14 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
15 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
16 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
17 otherwise by law.

19 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,  
29 2018.
