17	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Reques	sts, Executive
18	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in	the budget
19	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administrat	tion, letters, or
20	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arka	ansas Legislative
21	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage	e and adoption.

23	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	ed by the General
24	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the	e operations of
25	the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult a	and Behavioral
26	Health Services are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insuff	icient for the
27	Department of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult and I	Behavioral Health
28	Services to continue to provide essential governmental services	ces; that the
29	provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for	the Department
30	of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult and Behavioral H	Health Services
31	to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective	date of this Act
32	could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration as	nd provision of
33	essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is h	nereby declared
34	to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate prese	ervation of the
35	public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and es	ffect from and
36	after the date of its passage and approval.	

If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
