21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 91ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
22 OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 WHEREAS, Leadership Arkansas is a program introduced in 2005 by the  
25 Arkansas State Chamber of Commerce as an opportunity for individuals to gain  
26 a comprehensive view of the economic and political challenges that face the  
27 state and to experience the interactions between governmental bodies,  
28 industries, and the people they serve; and

29  
30 WHEREAS, Leadership Arkansas provides an opportunity during a one-day  
31 class session for each member of the yearly class to assume the role of a  
32 legislator and work with sitting elected legislative leaders and various  
33 special interest groups to move sample bills through the legislative process  
34 from introduction in the committee room to final passage or defeat on the  
35 chamber floor; and



1           WHEREAS, Leadership Arkansas includes participation by more than fifty  
2 (50) individuals representing businesses, organizations, municipalities, and  
3 state agencies across Arkansas,

5 NOW THEREFORE,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL  
7 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

9           THAT the House of Representatives of the Ninety-First General Assembly  
10 of the State of Arkansas recognizes Leadership Arkansas for its commitment to  
11 the legislative process and grants Leadership Arkansas access to and use of  
12 the chamber of the House of Representatives for a class session once a year,  
13 so long as the chamber of the House of Representatives is not in official use  
14 by the members of the House of Representatives.
