- 2 <u>COMPENSATION DIFFERENTIALS</u>. To address specific employee compensation needs,
- 3 <u>the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission (the Commission) is authorized to pay</u>
- 4 compensation differentials to employees occupying regularly appropriated
- 5 positions. All compensation differentials must be reviewed by the Arkansas
