SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
4	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of		
5	the Department of Veterans' Affairs are, due to unforeseen circumstances,		
6	insufficient for the Department of Veterans' Affairs to continue to provide		
7	essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide		
8	the necessary monies for the Department of Veterans' Affairs to continue such		
9	services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work		
10	irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential		
11	governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist		
12	and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public		
13	peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the		
14	date of its passage and approval.		
15	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
16	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
17	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
18	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
19	overrides the veto.
