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SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE GENERATION AND SUPPORT - COURTS. Unless specified otherwise in Arkansas Code 12 §5-4-303(g) and Arkansas Code 16-87-213 the monies collected by the courts 13 14 under the authority of §5-4-303(g) and 16-87-213 shall be deposited into the 15 State Treasury to the credit of the State Central Services Fund. 16 In the event that the law requires that the fees levied under 5-4-303(g)17 be deposited into the State Administration of Justice Fund, the State 18 Treasurer shall transfer the amount of the fees collected each month under

19 the authority of Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) from the State Administration of 20 Justice Fund to the State Central Services Fund.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
22 <u>2018</u> through June 30, 2018 <u>2019</u>.

SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEE GENERATION AND SUPPORT - BAIL BOND FEES. Unless specified otherwise in Arkansas Code §17-19-301(e) the monies collected by each bail bond company under the authority of §17-19-301(e) shall be deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the Public Defender User Fees Fund within the State Central Services Fund.

Of the fee collected by each licensed professional bail bond company, three dollars (\$3.00) shall be transferred to the various Counties for the sole purpose of defraying the operating expenses of the local public defenders' office. The remaining monies collected shall be used to defray operating expenses of the Commission.

36 On a quarterly basis, from the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item,

the Commission shall remit to each County its portion of the three dollars
 (\$3.00) per bail bond fee collected based upon the formula used for state aid
 for counties. This formula is as follows: 75% of the money is distributed
 equally to all 75 Counties and the remaining 25% is distributed per capita.
 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
 <u>2018</u> through June 30, 2018 2019.

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8 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 10 PROVISION. If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the 11 appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient, 12 appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program 13 line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving 14 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
16 <u>2018</u> through June 30, 2019.

18 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DUTIES OF 20 DEPENDENCY-NEGLECT APPEALS ATTORNEY. The Public Defender Commission shall 21 utilize Dependency-Neglect Appeals Attorneys exclusively to write appeals in 22 dependency-neglect cases.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
24 <u>2018</u> through June 30, 2018 <u>2019</u>.

26 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC 28 DEFENDERS. (a) No funds appropriated herein shall be used for expenses in 29 cases where a defendant is represented by retained counsel where retained counsel have not gone through the Public Defender Commission's attorney 30 31 certification procedure and designation process as established by state law 32 and the Commission's regulations. All defendants and retained attorneys must 33 strictly adhere to the procedure established by the Commission to equitably 34 and responsibly monitor and distribute State funds for this purpose.

35 (b) The Public Defender Commission may approve exemptions to subsection36 (a) as needed. Reasons for granting exemption should be specified in writing.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
 2018 through June 30, 2018 2019.

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4 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROVIDING 6 PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES AGREEMENT. The Public Defender Commission shall 7 have the authority to enter into a professional services agreement with a 8 person who is serving as a public defender or employed as an attorney with a 9 state agency when the employee has been appointed to provide defense 10 representation services by a judge. The total of the professional services 11 contract and the attorney's salary cannot exceed twenty-five percent (25%) 12 above the maximum of the pay grade of the employee's position. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017

14 <u>2018</u> through June 30, <del>2018</del> <u>2019</u>.

15

16 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 19 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25

26 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34

35 <u>SECTION 17. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,</u>
