21 SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 23 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary 24 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a 25 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 26 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees 27 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such 28 personnel.

29 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air 30 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and 31 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 32 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be 33 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in the Operations and Forestry 34 - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections. 35 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for 36 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is

by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in the Operations and Forestry - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017

SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO 12 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees 13 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for 14 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be 15 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to 16 expenditure.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017

SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Forestry Commission shall present the following data each month to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. This report shall be due by the 10th day of the month following the reporting period. The first reporting period shall be July 2012.

a) All fund transfers completed by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from
any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a justification
for the completion of the fund transfers.

b) All expenditures incurred by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from
any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a justification
for the expenditure of the funds.

c) All revenue receipts of the Arkansas Forestry Commission including
but not limited to federal funds, general revenue, severance tax, acreage
tax, timber sales and seedlings sales.

d) All Arkansas Forestry Commission activities including but not limited

1 to, firefighting activities, fire prevention, and emergency response as it 2 relates to the Commission's statutory mission provided in Arkansas Code 15-3 31-101.

7 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 9 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish 10 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional 11 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 12 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its 13 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be 14 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer 15 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas 16 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum 17 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general 18 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the 19 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums 20 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue 21 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that 22 23 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some 24 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing 25 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and 26 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior 27 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by 28 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or 29 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the 30 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 31 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire 32 section is void.

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SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall be authorized to create 3 paying accounts, on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of the 4 State and Auditor of State for the payment of all personal services and 5 operating expenses of the Department, as well as grant programs as determined 6 by the Secretary of the Arkansas Agriculture Department. The Chief Fiscal 7 Officer of the state shall direct the transfer of positions, funds and 8 appropriations to the paying accounts on the books of the Treasurer of State, 9 the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for the 10 efficient operations of the Department.

14 SECTION 45. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 15 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 17 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

24 SECTION 46. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 26 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 27 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 32
