Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in 5 the State Operations appropriation of this Act on June 30, 2018 2019, shall 6 be carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal 7 year ending June 30, 2019 2020. 8 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may 9 be carried forward under the following conditions: 10 (1) Prior to June 30, 2018 2019, the Agency shall by written statement set 11 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the 12 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 13 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2018.
