15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2018-2019 FISCAL
16 YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the College of The Ouachitas for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following
24 maximum number of regular employees.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the College of The Ouachitas for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: sixty (60) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the College of The Ouachitas, to be payable from the College of The Ouachitas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the College of The Ouachitas for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the College of The Ouachitas, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the College of The Ouachitas, for personal services and operating expenses of the College of The Ouachitas for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the following:

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8 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
10 PRIORITIES. A high priority of the College of The Ouachitas shall be to
11 combat illiteracy and to provide industrial training in the work place.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
13 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

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15 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HENDERSON
17 STATE UNIVERSITY AND COLLEGE OF THE OUACHITAS COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT.

18 (a) The General Assembly finds that:

19 (1) Henderson State University and College of The Ouachitas are
20 two institutions of Higher Education with a long history of cooperation and
21 mutual support for the pursuit of their missions to serve the residents of
22 their overlapping service areas;

23 (2) These institutions have entered into a memorandum of
24 understanding (the MOU) to continue the goodwill that has been established
25 between them and throughout the communities they serve, and to enhance the
26 level of services to the residents of Clark County without duplicating
27 efforts; and

28 (3) Working strategically, the institutions can meet the needs
29 of the residents of Clark County in a manner that fosters partnership and
30 collaboration.

31 (b) Based upon the agreement of the parties, the two institutions will work
32 collaboratively within the framework of the MOU for the betterment of
33 students in their service areas.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2017~~
35 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

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1 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
4 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
7 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
8 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
9 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
10 with in disbursement of said funds.

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12 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
22 2018.

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
