REAPPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, 6 to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the cash funds as 7 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for the Department of Parks and Tourism 8 the following: 9 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 10 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 360 of 2017, for maintenance and replacement 11 of Field Turf of War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed\$435,000. (B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 12 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 360 of 2017, for maintenance, renovation, 13 14 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair of the 15 Southwest Concourse Restrooms of War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed 16 17 (C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 18 in Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 360 of 2017, for replacement, maintenance, 19 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, and improvement of the 20 North and South Scoreboards of the War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed\$33,336. 21 22 (D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided 23 in Item (D) of Section 2 of Act 360 of 2017, for various maintenance, 24 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and 25 repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed\$6,771. 26 27 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL -STATE OWNED LANDS OR HISTORIC SITES. There is hereby appropriated, to the 28 29 Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Parks and 30 31 Tourism the following: 32 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management, 33 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, 34 35 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$6,799,003. 36

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1 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 2 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 3 4 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 5 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 6 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 7 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 8 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 9 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 10 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 11 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 12 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 21 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 29
