15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
16 HERITAGE REAPPROPRIATION.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION -
22 CONSERVATION TAX - AMENDMENT 75. There is hereby appropriated, to the
23 Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the Arkansas Department
24 of Heritage Fund Account, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - DAH -
25 Central Administration - Conservation Tax - Amendment 75 the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 361 of 2017, for special maintenance, in a
28 sum not to exceed\$983,189.
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30 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH ARKANSAS ARTS COUNCIL - ARTS COUNCIL
31 GRANT PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas
32 Heritage, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources
33 Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Arts Council
34 the following:

35 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 361 of 2017, for grants for Community Arts



1 Development and Arts Education programs, in a sum not to exceed\$7,500.

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3 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - CAPITAL
4 IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
5 Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the General Improvement
6 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas
7 Heritage the following:

8 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (A) of Section 15 of Act 361 of 2017, for maintenance, renovation,
10 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair of real
11 property, personal services, operating expenses and master plan development,
12 in a sum not to exceed\$140,000.

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14 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION -
15 ACQUISITION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas
16 Heritage, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
17 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 228 of 2017, for acquisition of the MRI
20 building, including the land, located at 906 South Broadway Street in Little
21 Rock, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$535,700.

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23 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - ACQUISITION
24 - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas
25 Heritage, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as
26 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
27 Arkansas Heritage the following:

28 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 228 of 2017, for acquisition of the MRI
30 building, including the land, located at 906 South Broadway Street in Little
31 Rock, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$1,344,300.

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33 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION - NCRC GRANTS.
34 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage -
35 Historic Preservation, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural
36 Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -

1 Historic Preservation the following:

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
4 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
5 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,700,000.

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7 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH NATURAL HERITAGE COMMISSION - NCRC
8 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage
9 - Natural Heritage Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
10 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas
11 Heritage - Natural Heritage Commission the following:

12 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
14 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
15 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,988,430.

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17 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - NCRC GRANTS.
18 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be
19 payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust
20 Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Central Administration the
21 following:

22 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
24 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
25 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$708,924.

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27 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH DELTA CULTURAL CENTER - NCRC GRANTS.
28 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta
29 Cultural Center, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural
30 Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -
31 Delta Cultural Center the following:

32 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
34 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
35 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$350,000.

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1 SECTION 10. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH ARKANSAS STATE ARCHIVES - NCRC
2 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas
3 Heritage, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources
4 Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Arkansas
5 State Archives the following:

6 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
8 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
9 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$325,000.

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11 SECTION 11. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH HISTORIC ARKANSAS MUSEUM - NCRC
12 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage
13 - Historic Arkansas Museum, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
14 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas
15 Heritage - Historic Arkansas Museum the following:

16 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
18 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
19 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$710,000.

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21 SECTION 12. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH MOSAIC TEMPLARS CULTURAL CENTER -
22 NCRC GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas
23 Heritage - Mosaic Templars Cultural Center, to be payable from the Arkansas
24 Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of
25 Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars Cultural Center the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
28 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
29 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$350,000.

30
31 SECTION 13. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH OLD STATE HOUSE - NCRC GRANTS. There
32 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Old State
33 House, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant
34 and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Old State House the
35 following:

36 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Section 23 of Act 234 of 2017, for the acquisition, management,
2 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
3 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$710,000.
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5 SECTION 14. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
6 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
7 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
8 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
9 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
10 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
11 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
12 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
13 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
14 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
15 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
16 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

17 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
18 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
19 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
20 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
21 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
22 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
23 otherwise by law.
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25 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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34 SECTION 16. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
35 2018.
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
