AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION - DIVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIC
FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
ENDING JUNE 30, 2019; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -
DIVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIC
FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2018-2019 FISCAL
YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
for the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic
Facilities and Transportation for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following
maximum number of regular employees.

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12 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 13 the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities
 14 and Transportation for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the following maximum
 15 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
 16 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary
 17 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
 18 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 19 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 22 to the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic
 23 Facilities and Transportation, to be payable from the Division of Public
 24 School Academic Facilities and Transportation Fund Account, for personal
 25 services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Division of
 26 Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation - Operations for the
 27 fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the following:

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7 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - PROGRAMS OF THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL

8 ACADEMIC FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the

9 Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and

10 Transportation, to be payable from the Educational Facilities Partnership

11 Fund Account, for grants and aid and special programs providing academic

12 school facility and transportation assistance to the public school districts

13 by the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic

14 Facilities and Transportation - Programs of the Division of Public School

15 Academic Facilities and Transportation for the fiscal year ending June 30,

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28 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

30 AUTHORITY - OPEN-ENROLLMENT PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL FACILITIES LOAN PROGRAM.

31 The Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities

32 and Transportation is authorized to transfer any funds that are made

33 available for the Open-Enrollment Public Charter School Facilities Loan

34 Program, including funds from the General Improvement Fund or its successor

35 fund or fund accounts, to the Open-Enrollment Public Charter School

36 Facilities Loan Fund.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
2 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

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4 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
6 AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education – Division of Public
7 School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the approval of the Chief
8 Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas Legislative
9 Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to request necessary
10 appropriation transfers and any other budget related adjustments necessary
11 only for the appropriations authorized in this Act. Furthermore, it is the
12 intent of the General Assembly that the Department of Education - Division of
13 Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation be able to make use of
14 additional contractual services as necessary and that transfers between line
15 items and among appropriations are anticipated to accomplish those purposes.
16 Provided, however, that the Department of Education - Division of Public
17 School Academic Facilities and Transportation shall be limited to submitting
18 no more than two transfer requests during any fiscal year.

19 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
20 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
21 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
22 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
23 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
24 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
25 has determined that the Department of Education – Division of Public School
26 Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some
27 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education –
28 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing
29 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is
30 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
31 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
32 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
33 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
34 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
35 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
36 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
2 2018 through June 30, ~~2018~~ 2019.

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4 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
24 2018.
