8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SECRETARY OF
10 STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

12 AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
13 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 Secretary of State the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for HVAC upgrade to North End of
26 State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$6,500,000.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for roof and window repair of
29 the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$2,500,000.

30 (C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for asphalt resurfacing,
32 replacement of damaged sidewalks and curbs, addition of lighting to unlit or
33 dark areas, an upgrade of the irrigation system, and landscaping and
34 plantings for the North Entry Promenade I and II of the State Capitol
35 Grounds, in a sum not to exceed\$538,112.

36 (D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided



1 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for drains and storm water
2 system renovations of the State Capitol Grounds, in a sum not to exceed
3\$483,000.

4 (E) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for interior plumbing and sump
6 pump replacement for the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed
7\$108,393.

8 (F) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for electrical panel replacement
10 in the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed\$212,980.

11 (G) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for expenses for State Capitol
13 as-built drawings, in a sum not to exceed\$250,000.

14 (H) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for "Green" Initiatives for the
16 State Capitol building, facilities and grounds including ventilation system
17 cleaning, energy efficiency improvements and assessment, analysis and
18 consulting services, recycling programs and/or related construction,
19 renovation and equipping of and/or conversion to or purchase of Compressed
20 Natural Gas vehicles and equipment including installation of a refueling
21 station, in a sum not to exceed\$1,500,000.

22 (I) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for replacement of voting
24 machine equipment statewide, in a sum not to exceed\$30,000,000.

25 (J) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (J) of Section 1 of Act 287 of 2017, for stone restoration, cleaning
27 and repointing on the East Side of the State Capitol building, in a sum not
28 to exceed\$3,500,000.

29 (K) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (L) of Section 1 of Act 348 of 2017, for construction, site
31 preparation and maintenance of the Arkansas Fallen Firefighters' Memorial on
32 the State Capitol Grounds or for upkeep, maintenance, preservation and repair
33 of all Monuments and Memorials on the grounds of the State Capitol, in a sum
34 not to exceed\$32,307.

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36 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

1 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
13 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
14 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
15 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
17 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
18 otherwise by law.

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20 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
30 2018.

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
