## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STATE MILITARY  
DEPARTMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT  
REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

### SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT CAPITAL PROJECTS.

There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the State Military Department the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction of a Youth Program Facility for the Civilian Student Training Program and Youth Challenge Program, in a sum not to exceed .....\$10,000,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation projects for ADA compliance for Armories, in a sum not to exceed ...\$750,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation of the Readiness Center located at 17303 Camp J.T. Robinson, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,852,606.

(D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation



of the Readiness Center located at 24346 Camp J.T. Robinson, in a sum not to exceed .....\$988,665.

(E) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 227 of 2017, for upgrades and improvements associated with Readiness Center Energy Projects at Arkansas National Guard Readiness Centers throughout the state, in a sum not to exceed ...\$1,070,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, renovation, roof repair/replacement, upgrade latrines, upgrade windows and doors, parking and road resurfacing, and general facility maintenance for sustainment, restoration and modernization projects of the Arkansas Army National Guard Readiness Centers throughout the state, in a sum not to exceed ...\$8,025,025.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the State Military Department the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 406 of 2017, for construction of the Camp Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,557,817.

(B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 2 of Act 406 of 2017, for construction and renovation of Professional Education Center Dining Facility, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,850,089.

(C) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) of Section 2 of Act 406 of 2017, for construction and renovation projects for ADA compliance, in a sum not to exceed .....\$750,000.

(D) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) of Section 2 of Act 406 of 2017, for construction and renovation of the Searcy Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed .....\$7,407,510.

(E) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 2 of Act 406 of 2017, for construction of the Fort Chaffee Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed ....\$5,187,100.

(F) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) of Section 2 of Act 406 of 2017, for construction of the Fort Chaffee Sewer System, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,220,223.

1 (G) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 2 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation  
 3 projects for ADA compliance for Armories, in a sum not to exceed ...\$750,000.

4 (H) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 5 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for upgrades and improvements  
 6 associated with Camp J.T. Robinson Energy Projects, in a sum not to exceed  
 7 .....\$3,210,000.

8 (I) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 9 in Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for upgrades and improvements  
 10 associated with Camp J.T. Robinson Solar Array Project, in a sum not to  
 11 exceed .....\$1,867,890.

12 (J) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 13 in Item (D) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, renovation,  
 14 roof repair/replacement, upgrade latrines, upgrade windows and doors, parking  
 15 and road resurfacing, and general facility maintenance for sustainment,  
 16 restoration and modernization projects at Camp J.T. Robinson, in a sum not to  
 17 exceed .....\$10,700,000.

18 (K) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 19 in Item (E) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation  
 20 of Dining Facility Building 2501, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,853,078.

21 (L) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 22 in Item (F) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, upgrades and  
 23 improvements associated with Fort Chaffee Energy Projects, in a sum not to  
 24 exceed .....\$3,210,000.

25 (M) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 26 in Item (G) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, upgrades and  
 27 improvements associated with Fort Chaffee Solar Array Project, in a sum not  
 28 to exceed .....\$1,867,890.

29 (N) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 30 in Item (H) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, renovation,  
 31 roof repair/replacement, upgrade latrines, upgrade windows and doors, parking  
 32 and road resurfacing, and general facility maintenance for sustainment,  
 33 restoration and modernization projects at Fort Chaffee, in a sum not to  
 34 exceed .....\$10,700,000.

35 (O) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 36 in Item (I) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction of Camp J.T.

1 Robinson Maryland Gate Access Control, in a sum not to exceed ....\$2,193,360.

2 (P) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
3 in Item (J) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction of Camp J.T.  
4 Robinson Multi-Purpose Machinegun Range, in a sum not to exceed ..\$5,859,500.

5 (Q) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
6 in Item (K) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation  
7 of the Readiness Center located at 17303 Camp J.T. Robinson, in a sum not to  
8 exceed .....\$5,557,817.

9 (R) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
10 in Item (L) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction and renovation  
11 of the Readiness Center located at 24346 Camp J.T. Robinson, in a sum not to  
12 exceed .....\$2,965,995.

13 (S) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
14 in Item (M) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for upgrades and improvements  
15 associated with Readiness Center Energy Projects at Arkansas National Guard  
16 Readiness Centers throughout the state, in a sum not to exceed ...\$1,070,000.

17 (T) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
18 in Item (N) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, renovation,  
19 roof repair/replacement, upgrade latrines, upgrade windows and doors, parking  
20 and road resurfacing, and general facility maintenance for sustainment,  
21 restoration and modernization projects of the Arkansas Army National Guard  
22 Readiness Centers throughout the state, in a sum not to exceed ...\$8,025,025.

### 23 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARMORY CONSTRUCTION FUND CAPITAL PROJECTS.

24 There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable  
25 from the Armory Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the  
26 following:  
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28 (A) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
29 in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 406 of 2017, for repair, construction,  
30 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other  
31 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a  
32 sum not to exceed .....\$2,348,000.

33 (B) Effective July 1, 2018, the balance of the appropriation provided  
34 in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 227 of 2017, for construction, improvement,  
35 or equipping of Arkansas National Guard Readiness Centers throughout the  
36 state, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,500,000.

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2 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
3 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
4 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
5 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
6 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
7 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
8 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
9 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
10 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
11 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
12 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
13 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

14 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
15 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
16 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
17 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
18 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
19 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
20 otherwise by law.  
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22 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
24 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
25 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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31 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,  
32 2018.  
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
