3 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 5 TRANSFERS. If the Speaker of the House and the Chief of Staff or his designee 6 determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a specific 7 purpose is not needed for such purposes, they may certify such fact to the 8 State Auditor, and the State Auditor shall cause transfer to be made from one 9 item to another.

11 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF 13 APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the 14 expenses of the House of Representatives of the Legislative Session of the 15 Ninety-First Ninety-Second General Assembly, and upon adjournment of the 16 Legislative Session, any unexpended balance of the funds appropriated in this 17 Act may be used to defray the necessary expenses of the operation of the 18 Office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Office of the 19 Chief of Staff, the Office of the Coordinator of House Legislative Services, 20 the Office of Parliamentarian, the Chief Clerk's Office, House Member 21 Services Office and other reasonable and necessary expenses of the House of 22 Representatives of the Ninety-First Ninety-Second General Assembly incurred 23 during the interim between the adjournment of the Legislative Session of the 24 Ninety-First Ninety-Second General Assembly and July 1, 2018 2019.

Additionally, if it is determined by the Speaker of the House that the presence, assistance, oversight and expertise of any House member is needed and if it is determined by the Speaker of the House that certain expenses and per diem of members of the House should be paid by the House, such expenses and per diem at the rate authorized for attending legislative sessions shall be paid from the funds appropriated herein for Maintenance, Operations and Expenses.

33 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY 35 LEVELS. The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Chief of Staff or 36 his designee shall, during the month of June, each fiscal year, meet and

determine the actual salaries to be paid each employee beginning the following July 1. Such salaries of the employees will be based upon an evaluation of the performance of the Chief of Staff by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and upon an evaluation of the performance of the other employees by the Chief of Staff or his designee. SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the House of Representatives of the 92nd General Assembly convenes in Regular Session on January 14, 2019; that expenses of the session begin immediately; and that the expenses are a just expense of the state which must be paid at the time the services are provided. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become

16 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor

17 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is

18 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides

- 19 the veto.
