## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL TO PROVIDE BLEEDING CONTROL TRAINING TO EACH STUDENT IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle<br>to require each public school to provide bleeding control training to each student in grades nine through twelve (9-12).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1 , is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-10-133. Bleeding control training.
(a) Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, each public school shall provide bleeding control training as a component of a health course to each student in grades nine through twelve (9-12).
(b) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the Department of Health, shall develop the bleeding control training required under this section using instructional materials developed or endorsed by the:
(1) American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma;
(2) National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians; or
(3) Department of Health.
(c) The Department of Education shall promulgate rules to enforce this section.
