#### Abstract

For An Act To Be Entitled AN ACT TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL TO PROVIDE BLEEDING CONTROL TRAINING TO EACH STUDENT IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12) BEFORE THE STUDENT GRADUATES FROM HIGH SCHOOL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1 , is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-10-133. Bleeding control training.
(a) Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, each public school shall provide bleeding control training as a component of a health course to each student in grades nine through twelve (9-12) before the student graduates from high school.
(b) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the Department of Health, shall develop the bleeding control training required under this section using instructional materials developed or endorsed by the:
(1) American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma;
(2) National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians; or
