22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-90-1413(c), concerning the time period
23	before which a court may grant a uniform petition to seal a criminal record
24	under the Comprehensive Criminal Record Sealing Act of 2013, is amended to
25	read as follows:
26	(c)(l) The court may not grant the uniform petition until <del>ninety (90)</del>
27	thirty (30) days have passed since the uniform petition was served on the
28	prosecuting attorney, although the court may deny the uniform petition at any
29	time.
30	(2) If the court determines that the record shall be sealed
31	under the standards of § $16-90-1415$ , the uniform order described in § $16-90-1415$
32	1414 shall be entered and filed with the circuit court clerk or district
33	court clerk, as applicable.
