25	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 22-9-203, concerning the award procedure			
26	for public improvements generally, is amended to add additional subsections			
27	to read as follows:			
28	(1) A governing body of a municipality by ordinance may waive the			
29	requirements of competitive bidding if an event imminently threatens the			
30	orderly operations of the municipality or if an established imminent safety			
31	hazard is present that renders competitive bidding not feasible or practical.			
32	(m) Purchases and contracts made under this section shall not be			
33	subdivided for the purpose of avoiding competitive bidding required under			
34	this section.
