18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-10-305(h), concerning court costs	
21	designated for the Domestic Violence Shelter Fund, is amended to read as	
22	follows:	
23	(h)(l) An additional court cost of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall	1
24	be assessed and remitted to the Administration of Justice Funds Section	
25	within the Department of Finance and Administration by the court clerk <u>or</u>	
26	designee under § 16-13-709(a) for deposit as special revenues into the	
27	Domestic Violence Shelter Fund if a person is a convicted perpetrator of a	
28	domestic abuse offense or is the respondent on a permanent order of	
29	protection entered by a court under the Domestic Abuse Act of 1991, § 9-15-	
30	101 et seq.	
31	(2) When a convicted person is authorized to make installment	
32	payments under § 16-13-704, the court cost assessed under subdivision (h)(1	)
33	of this section shall be collected from the initial installment payment	
34	first.	
35	(3) The court clerk or designee under § 16-13-709(a) shall	
36	disburse all court costs collected each month under subdivision (h)(1) of	

1	this section to the Administration of Justice Funds Section by the fifteenth
2	working day of the following month.

4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-13-701 is amended to read as follows:
5	16-13-701. Scope <u>— Definition</u> .
6	(a) The procedures established by this subchapter shall apply to the
7	assessment and collection of all monetary fines, however designated, imposed
8	by circuit courts and district courts for criminal convictions, traffic
9	convictions, civil violations, and juvenile delinquency adjudications and
10	shall be utilized to obtain prompt and full payment of all such fines.
11	(b) For purposes of As used in this subchapter, the term "fine" or
12	"fines" means all monetary penalties imposed by the courts of this state,
13	which include fines, court costs, restitution, probation fees, and public
14	service work supervisory fees. a monetary penalty imposed by a court,
15	including without limitation:
16	(1) A monetary fine;
17	(2) Court costs;
18	(3) Court-ordered restitution;
19	(4) Probation fees;
20	(5) Supervision fees;
21	(6) Public service supervisory fees; and
22	(7) Other court-ordered fees.
