9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD
10 OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE
11 30, 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF
15 PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE
16 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Arkansas State Board of Public Accountancy for the 2019-2020 fiscal
24 year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

 4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 5 the Arkansas State Board of Public Accountancy for the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
 6 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known
 7 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes:
 8 one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 9 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 10 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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 12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 13 to the Arkansas State Board of Public Accountancy, to be payable from cash
 14 funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State Board of
 15 Public Accountancy, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 16 Arkansas State Board of Public Accountancy for the fiscal year ending June
 17 30, 2020, the following:

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 34 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 36 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,

1 the Arkansas State Board of Public Accountancy is hereby authorized to
2 transfer appropriation from Operating Expenses to Promotional Items in the
3 appropriation authorized by this Act in an amount not to exceed five hundred
4 dollars (\$500) each fiscal year to meet the Board's educational needs.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019
6 through June 30, 2020.

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8 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

1 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

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
