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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Arkansas Waterways Commission for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
36 to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous



1 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 2 Arkansas Waterways Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the

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 18 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - WATERWAY DEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM. There
 19 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable
 20 from the Arkansas Port, Intermodal, and Waterway Development Grant Program
 21 Fund, for grants to port authorities and intermodal authorities under the
 22 Arkansas Port, Intermodal, and Waterway Development Grant Program for port
 23 development projects as defined by Arkansas Code § 15-23-205 for the fiscal
 24 year ending June 30, 2020, the following:

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 30 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 32 ASSOCIATION DUES. Of the amounts appropriated for regional contributions by
 33 the State Contributions line item in the Operations appropriation of this
 34 Act, three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00), or three-sevenths (3/7) whichever is
 35 less of the appropriated or funded amount, each fiscal year shall be
 36 allocated for membership dues for the Lower Mississippi Valley Flood Control

1 Association and one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or one-seventh (1/7)
 2 whichever is less of the appropriated or funded amount, each fiscal year
 3 shall be allocated for membership dues for each of the following
 4 associations: Ouachita River Valley Association, Red River Valley
 5 Association, Arkansas Waterways Association, and White River Valley
 6 Coalition.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
 8 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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 10 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 12 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
 13 the Arkansas Waterways Commission is hereby authorized to transfer
 14 appropriation from Operating Expenses to Promotional Items in the Operations
 15 Appropriation provided by this Act in an amount not to exceed one thousand
 16 five hundred dollars (\$1,500) each fiscal year to meet the Commission's
 17 educational/outreach needs.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019
 19 through June 30 2020.

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 21 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 31 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 33 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 34 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 4 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 6 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
 8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 9 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 10 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
 11 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 12 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 13 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 14 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

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
