Arkansas Code § 23-99-902(4), concerning the definition of "risk-sharing payment" as used in alternative payment systems, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows: (4)(A) "Risk-sharing payment" means a reduction in a payment to or refund of a payment already made to a physician as a result of patient care costs that exceed cost thresholds of any form. (B) "Risk-sharing payment" does not mean a gift card, credit card, or other type of electronic payment or virtual credit card as payment if the method of payment charges the physician a service fee to process.
