16	TO PROHIBIT AN INSURER FROM REQUIRING
17	PAYMENT FOR HEALTHCARE SERVICES THROUGH
18	GIFT CARDS, CREDIT CARDS, OR VIRTUAL
19	CREDIT CARDS.

22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23	
24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-76-119, concerning prohibited practices
25	of health maintenance organizations, is amended to add an additional
26	subsection to read as follows:
27	(d)(1) A health maintenance organization or its contractor or
28	subcontractor may pay a claim for healthcare services by any lawful method,
29	including the alternative payment method by gift card, credit card, or other
30	type of electronic payment or virtual credit card as payment if the
31	healthcare provider is given clear instructions about how to select the
32	alternative payment method.
33	(2) However, a health maintenance organization or its contractor
34	or subcontractor is prohibited from requiring a participating provider to
35	accept a gift card, credit card, or other type of electronic payment or
36	virtual credit card as payment of a claim for healthcare services if the

1	method of payment charges the participating provider a service fee to
2	process.
3	
4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-99-204, concerning the terms of a health
5	benefit plan, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
6	(c)(1) A healthcare insurer may pay a claim for healthcare services by
7	any lawful method, including the alternative payment method by gift card,
8	credit card, or other type of electronic payment or virtual credit card as
9	payment if the healthcare provider is given clear instructions about how to
10	select the alternative payment method.
11	(2) However, a healthcare insurer is prohibited from requiring a
12	healthcare provider to accept a gift card, credit card, or other type of
13	electronic payment or virtual credit card as payment of a claim for
14	healthcare services if the method of payment charges the healthcare provider
15	a service fee to process.
16	
17	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-99-902(4), concerning the definition of
18	"risk-sharing payment" as used in alternative payment systems, is amended to
19	add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
20	(4)(A) "Risk-sharing payment" means a reduction in a payment to
21	or refund of a payment already made to a physician as a result of patient
22	care costs that exceed cost thresholds of any form.
23	(B) "Risk-sharing payment" includes the alternative
24	payment method by gift card, credit card, or other type of electronic payment
25	or virtual credit card as payment if the physician is given clear
26	instructions about how to select an alternative payment method that does not
27	result in the physician's being charged a service fee to process.
