- 1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LOANS TO CITIES AND COUNTIES. On July 1 of each fiscal year, the Chief Fiscal Officer 3 4 of the State shall request a transfer by the State Treasurer from the Budget 5 Stabilization Trust Fund to the County Aid Fund and to the Municipal Aid Fund 6 to assist the various cities and counties in meeting cash flow needs early in 7 the state fiscal year. The transfer shall be a loan to be repaid in equal 8 installments from general revenue distributions each month during the fiscal 9 year for which the loan was made and shall be in addition to any other loans 10 authorized by law for the County Aid and Municipal Aid Funds. The amount of 11 such loan for each fiscal year shall be \$3,517,657 to the Municipal Aid Fund 12 and \$1,906,079 to the County Aid Fund, or so much thereof as may be available in the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund as determined by the Chief Fiscal 13 14 Officer of the State. Upon such transfer being completed, the State 15 Treasurer shall immediately distribute such funds to each of the several 16 municipalities and counties in the same manner as general revenues are 17 distributed. 18 It is the intent of the General Assembly that the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 19 State and the State Treasurer shall make every reasonable, and financially 20 sound effort to insure that local governments receive the full amount of the 21 loan authorized herein on July 1 of each year and that the monies authorized 22 for local governments from general revenues be distributed in equal monthly 23 payments.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018 25 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

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SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year any unexpended funds for the County Aid and Municipal Aid line items shall be carried forward and distributed pursuant and in addition to the funding formula established under A.C.A 19-5-601 and 19-5-602 within forty-five (45) days.

- Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:
- 35 (1) Prior to June 30, $\frac{2019}{2020}$ the Agency shall by written statement 36 set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the

- 5 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 6 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
- 7 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
- 8 written request set forth in (1) above;
- 9 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a
- 10 written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 11 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 12 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 13 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- 14 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 15 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
- 16 Committee; and
- 17 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
- 18 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals
- 19 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 20 Institution.

- 24 SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 27-70-207, concerning distribution of
- 25 highway revenues to cities and counties, is amended to add an additional
- 26 subsection to read as follows:
- 27 (f) A county or municipality that receives a distribution under this
- 28 section or under \S 26-58-124 of two million dollars (\S 2,000,000) or more
- 29 shall report annually by March 15 to the House Committee on Public
- 30 Transportation and the Senate Committee on Public Transportation, Technology,
- 31 and Legislative Affairs the following information regarding the use of the
- 32 funds in the previous year:
- 33 (1) The use of the funds;
- 34 (2)(A) A general ledger accounting of the city street or road
- 35 <u>fund or the county street or road fund.</u>
- 36 <u>(B) The county street or road fund general ledger</u>

1 accounting shall be made using the County Financial Management System of 2 tracking county revenues and expenditures; 3 (3) The percentage of the city street or road fund or county 4 street or road fund that is comprised of state funds; and 5 (4) The details of each contracted project, including without 6 limitation the type and description of the contracted project and the total 7 amount expended on the contracted project. SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 10 11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 17 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 26 27 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 29 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 35

being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

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1	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
