35	is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usuall	y accomplished by	
36	delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a	state agency and	

- 1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 3 has determined that the Department of Information Systems may operate more
- 4 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Information
- 5 Systems authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both
- 6 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
- 7 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee

- 16 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GIFTS,
- 18 GRANTS AND DONATIONS. (i) The Director may accept on behalf of the Department
- 19 of Information Systems, from any source, funds including but not limited to
- 20 special or general revenue, gifts, grants, cash, bequeaths, devices,
- 21 donations, real or personal property and equipment. (ii) The Department shall
- 22 quarterly file with the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 23 Committee a report summarizing all funds, gifts, grants, cash, bequeaths,
- 24 devices, donations, real or personal property and equipment received. (iii)
- 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018 2019
- 26 through June 30, 2019 <u>2020</u>.

- 28 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 30 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 31 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
3	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
4	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
5	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
6	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
7	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
8	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
9	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
10	
11	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
12	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
13	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
17	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
18	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
19	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
20	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
21	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
